CHECKLIST

1. THINK ABOUT MOOD	•
Does your setting fit your story's genre?	Does it create an appropriate mood?
Are your setting details in harmony with each other, to form a coherent feeling/impression?	Does your setting allow for the needs of the story (plot, character movement, genre conventions)?
2. MAKE IT MATTER	
Does your setting play an important role in the plot or events of the story?	Does your setting provide challenges and/or important resources for your character?
Does your setting spur your character toward further growth in some way?	
3. USE ALL 5 SENSES	
Have you included visual descriptions of your setting?	Have you described what sounds are present (both prominent and in the background)?
Have you shown your character experiencing your setting's smells?	Have you described how things feel
Have you described how things taste?	(temperature, texture, consistency, etc.)?
4. IMAGINE THE SETTING AS	A CHARACTER IN THE STORY
Does your setting leave a distinct and memorable impression?	Does it play a valid role in your story and some kind of impact on the plot?
Does it have unique characteristics that set it apart from other, more generic settings?	some kind of impact on the plot?
5. DESCRIBE THROUGH IMPRESSIONS	
Have you used metaphors, similes, imagery or other literary devices in describing your setting?	Have you described the setting through its effects rather than just through its upfront physical characteristics?
